LIMITS:

Daily limit is 4 trout; one can be a brown trout over 20 inches.
Possession limit is 8 trout in which two can be browns over 20 inches.

Bait Fishermen: Public access at Cooper Creek, downtown Branson, Rockaway Beach and Ozark Beach. Best live baits are air-injected night crawlers, minnows, power eggs in white, pink, orange and salmon eggs. Most important – use light line, 2-4 pound test, small weights and small hooks.

Best lures are jigs, crank baits, spinners and spoons. Try a jig-n-float, fishing a jig under a float 4 to 5 feet deep. Use 1/100th ounce brown, black, olive, white, ginger, pink or sculpin colored jigs. Troll or cast other baits.

Trophy Area: Upper 3.5 miles extending from Table Rock Dam to the mouth of Fall Creek. Special rules apply – flies and lures only. No scented or soft plastics allowed. Rainbows between 12-20 inches must be released.

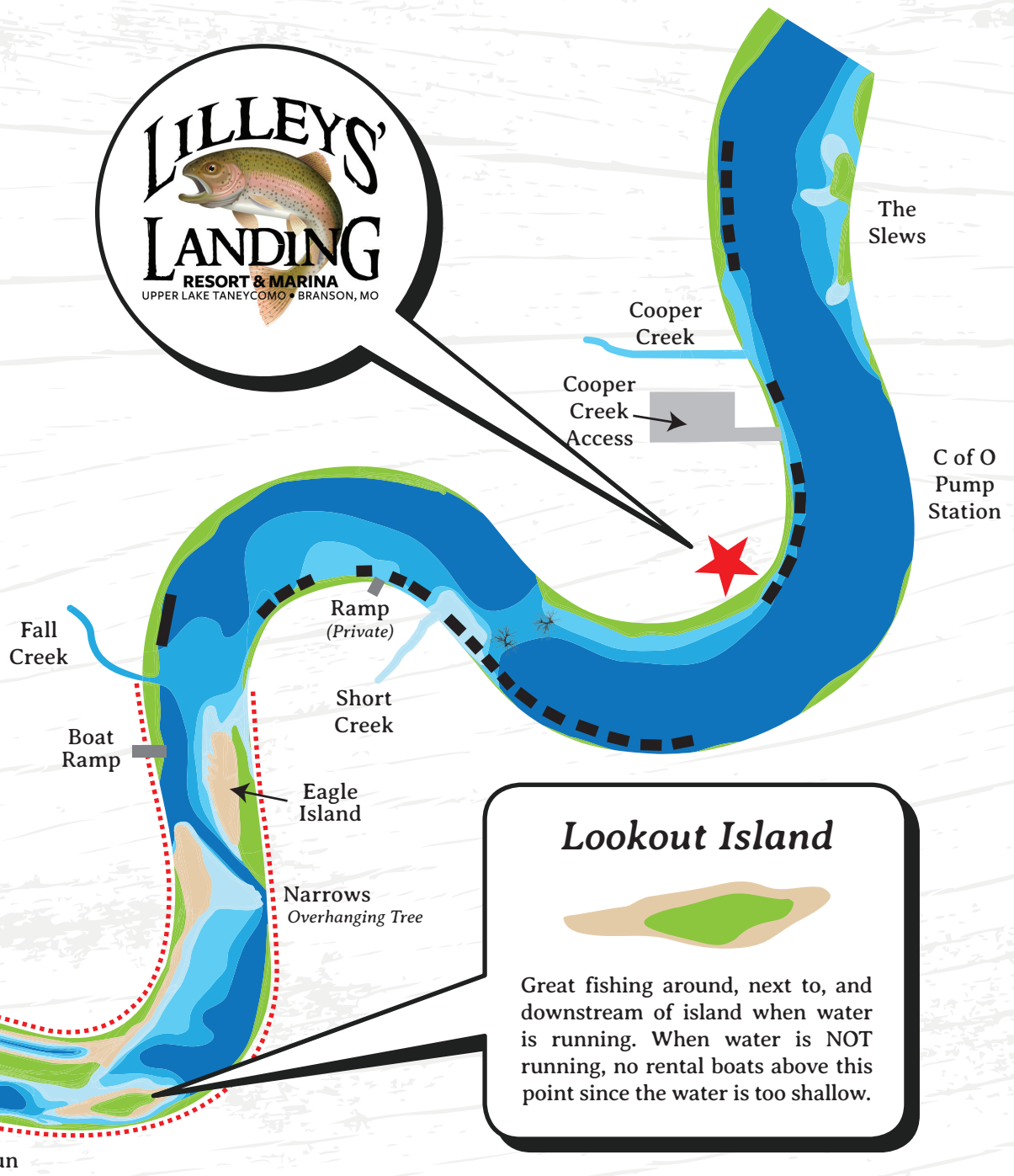
Seasons: Trout anglers will find good trout fishing in the winter time. Fishing pressure is low and water quality high in the cold months. Spring usually brings heavy generation but not always. Look for threadfin shad flowing in from Table Rock Lake, our trout's favorite snack. More trout are stocked in summer months so there's more to catch. Fall means brown trout are moving up lake for their spawning run.

Lookout Island

Great fishing around, next to, and downstream of island when water is running. When water is NOT running, no rental boats above this point since the water is too shallow.
